2015 SAGE Summative Writing At-A-Glance Field Test: February 2-20, 2015

Changes for 2015 SAGE Summative Writing

- 50% shorter stimulus (text sets) for Opinion/Argumentative (Informative-Explanatory same as 2014)
- Expected essay length is shorter for Informative-Explanatory in 2015 (see chart below)
- Time guidelines changed and clarified for 3rd-5th Opinion and 6th-11th Argumentative essays

Notes

- All 3rd-11th grade students will be given two (2) SAGE Summative Writing prompts.
- 2015 is a Field Test again for SAGE Writing because of changes in text sets and expected essay length.
- SAGE Summative Writing Scores will be available when 2015 SAGE Summative ELA test is completed.
- Rubrics in SAGE Portal Resources contain information about how essays are graded and weighted.
- Any grade may practice using any SAGE Summative Writing Training Test. All include an example stimulus, prompt, and scoring guide: 3-5 Opinion/6-8 Argumentative/9-11 Informative-Explanatory

3rd-5th SAGE Summative Writing Prompts

3rd-5th OPINION

LENGTH 3rd-4th grade: 1-3 paragraph essay 5th grade: 3 paragraphs or more are needed to write a good opinion

TIME: 60-90 minutes (officially untimed)

STIMULUS/TEXT SETS:

- 50% shorter than 2014
- at least two passages, most prompts will have multiple passages
- min/max word count for passages is based upon grade level and words per minute(wpm) reading targets

When 3rd-5th students submit the Opinion essay the Informative-Explanatory prompt becomes available and students are unable to go back to the first prompt.

3rd-5th INFORMATIVE-EXPLANATORY

LENGTH: 1-3 paragraph explanation

TIME: 60-90 minutes (officially untimed)

STIMULUS/TEXT SETS: same as 2014

6th-11th SAGE Summative Writing Prompts

6th-11th ARGUMENTATIVE

LENGTH: 4-6 paragraph essay - Darron Kennett, USOE, suggests it would be hard to write a good argument in 3 paragraphs or less

TIME: 60-90 minutes (officially untimed)

STIMULUS/TEXT SETS:

- 50% shorter than 2014
- at least two passages, most prompts will have multiple passages
- min/max word count for passages is based upon grade level and words per minute (wpm) reading targets

When 6th-11th students submit the Argumentative essay the Informative/Explanatory prompt becomes available and students are unable to go back to the first prompt.

6th-11th INFORMATIVE-EXPLANATORY

LENGTH: 2-3 paragraph explanation

TIME: 60-90 minutes (officially untimed)

STIMULUS/TEXT SETS: same as 2014
